K&N® Cabin Air Filters replace your vehicle's stock cabin filter with a reusable design that cleans and freshens incoming air. They are electrostatically charged to grab and hold dust particles. K&N® cabin air filters help control odors while they help capture most mold, mildew, fungus, spores, bacteria and germs. When they get dirty they can be cleaned and reused and best of all, they come with a 10 year/Million mile limited warranty.

When applicable, refer to owner's manual for manufacturers installation/removal instructions. The following are helpful steps when replacing/servicing cabin air filter with K&N® cabin air filter.

1. Remove or fold over the floor mats on the passenger side. Fig. 1
2. Remove the two screws, plastic cover and styrofoam block to access the cabin air filter housing. Fig. 1,2,3
3. Locate and remove the cabin air filter door. Fig. 4
4. Remove the dirty cabin filters. Clean any debris that might present inside the housing. Fig. 5 & 6  
**NOTE: There's two cabin filters in the housing. A tool may be required to slide and remove the second cabin filter from the housing.**
5. Install both K&N® cabin air filters into the housing. Fig. 7 & 8  
**NOTE: Install the first filter with the K&N® pull strap facing up and out (Fig. 7) then install the second filter with the K&N® pull strap facing down and out (Fig. 8).**
6. Tuck the pull straps in the housing and reverse steps 1-3 to complete the cabin filter installation. With the K&N® cabin filter installed, clean an area and apply the K&N® Stop Decal. The decal will help notify others that these are reusable cabin filters.

When applicable, refer to owner's manual for manufacturers installation/removal instructions. The following are helpful steps when replacing/servicing cabin air filter with K&N® cabin air filter.

1. Locate the panel on the passenger side and remove the screw in the indicated location. (Figs. 1 & 2)
2. Grasp the panel using the opening, pull the panel outwards to release the tabs, then pull it towards the seat to remove it from the tunnel. Release the clip on the wiring harness and remove the panel. (Figs. 3 & 4)
3. Push the tab forward and remove the filter cover. (Fig. 5)
4. Remove the two filters from the tray. The second filter will have to be raised up to get it out (Fig. 6)
5. Install the first K&N® cabin filter with the strap up. (Fig. 7)
6. Install the second K&N® cabin filter with the strap down. (Fig. 8)
7. Reverse steps 1-3 to complete the cabin filter installation. With the cabin filters installed, clean an area and apply the K&N® Stop Decal. The decal will help notify others that these are reusable cabin filters.
